Limestone variant 1b is a finely structured form of Version 1a and can be combined as desired.

In the "medium" and "grey" shades, the rock structure gradually fades further into the background, creating new designs and rock simulations.



✓ Limestone variant 2 has rock structures alternating between coarse and fine and is perfect for combining with variants 1a/b and 5.



Limestone variant 5 light complements the variants shown above with additional interesting rock formations.

With the "muted" and "ochre" shades, it's possible to create interesting variations in colour that truly reflect nature.

Both shades also fit in well with US layouts.

Looking at the entire 212 x 105 cm rock face is a very impressive experience!

You've probably walked through mountain pasture at some time and noticed the many large and small rocky areas on the slopes and in the meadows. It's areas like these that you can now recreate on the model using the new variant 6a "mountain pasture".



TIP: The "yellow" sandstone goes excellently with limestone variant 5 "ochre". The "light" and "grey" sandstone can also be combined with the colour shades from the limestone series, creating a more diverse appearance.









Using these special printed rock structures and the "wrinkling" technique, you can quickly produce astonishingly realistic rock formations, even entire rock faces, using a lightweight building method. The "Wrinkle Rocks" product offers an interesting alternative to traditional rock construction methods and can also be used in combination with them.

Processing instructions

DESIGN: matt inkjet print (pigmented ink, waterproof) on special **blueback paper** (can be more finely wrinkled) or heavy **non-woven material** (ideal for covering large areas). Try out and feel both materials to find your favourite.

WRINKLE: The prints can be processed wet or dry. Take a piece of rock print and crumple it up firmly into a little ball – unfold it and assess the result. If you want a finer texture, crumple it up again 1-3 times. You can also lightly rub the rock print together between your fingers to make the material malleable. Just trying and testing yourself is the best option here.

INSTALL: Design and create an appropriate supporting structure using polystyrene/Styrodur boards - roughly cut the boards to the desired mountain shape. Place spots of PVA glue all over the boards, lay out the previously wrinkled rock prints and mould and ease them into the desired shape. If you prefer the rock prints to be self-supporting, the Wrinkle Rocks can be stiffened by glueing 1-3 additional layers of paper to the back. This makes it possible to span larger areas without elaborate substructures.

LANDSCAPE: The wrinkled surface can be customised by painting and adding vegetation. There are no bare rocks in nature (apart from those recently broken) – you should definitely include moss, areas of pasture, boulders, bushes, mountain pines, woodland trees, paths, fences, etc.
